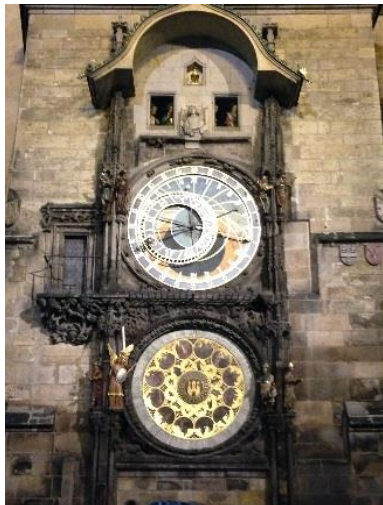


# PRAGUE & SOUTHERN POLAND

## TOUR ITINERARY:

**MAY 7 - THU TRANSATLANTIC OVERNIGHT FLIGHT TO PRAGUE (not included in the land only tour price)**

**MAY 8 - FRI ARRIVE PRAGUE (WELCOME DINNER)**

Arrive Prague and transfer to our hotel. ( Transfer included only if arriving on group flight )  
Free time until we meet this evening for our Welcome Dinner.

**MAY 9 - SAT PRAGUE ( B, D )**

Today we start the tour by bus for a panoramic view of the highlights of Prague such as the Republic Square (Namesti Republiky), Wenceslas Square ( Vaclavske Namesti ), National Theatre, the Prague Castle (UNESCO site) and the Charles Bridge. From here we will walk to the Old Town Square with its famous landmarks such as the Church of Our Lady before Tyn, and the unique Astronomical Clock from the year 1410. We will end our tour at the old town so that you can enjoy the rest of the afternoon at your leisure. Dinner tonight at a local restaurant with traditional folklore.

**MAY 10 - SUN PRAGUE - BOLESLAWIEC - WROCLAW ( B, L )**

We leave Prague and travel east towards Poland. In the early afternoon we arrive at the picturesque town of Boleslawiec, where we will have lunch and then visit one of the ceramic workshops that produce the famous Boleslawiec Polish Pottery. You will have plenty of free time to shop before we continue to Wroclaw. The evening is yours to enjoy at your leisure.

**MAY 11 - MON WROCLAW ( B, D )**

Today we familiarize ourselves with the dynamic city of Wroclaw. After breakfast we will take a short drive to visit Ostrów Tumski (Cathedral Island) with its impressive collection of historic buildings, including the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist. From here we will start our walking tour to experience some of the most architecturally picturesque parts of the city, including a stop at the Market Hall before ending our walk at the famous Old Town Square with it's magnificent Old Town Hall. Free time for lunch and exploring on your own. In the evening we will dine at one of the charming restaurants near the Old Town Square.

## **MAY 12 - TUE WROCLAW - TYCHY (TYSKIE BREWERY) - WADOWICE - ZAKOPANE ( B, L, D )**

From Wroclaw we first drive southeast to Tychy, the town where the world famous "Tyskie" beer is made. We will have a tour of the brewery including beer tasting and then continue to Wadowice where we will stop for lunch and then a short visit in the town where St John Paul II was born on May 18, 1920. This year marks the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of His birth. We will visit the church where the young Karol Wojtyla was christened and later served as altar boy. Time to enjoy a kremowka {JP II's favorite dessert) before we continue our drive to Zakopane in the very southern part of Poland at the foot of the Tatra mountains.

Early evening arrival in Zakopane for dinner and overnight.

## **MAY 13 - WED ZAKOPANE ( B, D )**

After breakfast see the highlights of Zakopane including the wooden chapel at Jaszczurowka, the ski-jump hill, and the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima. Our tour will end with a cable car (funicular) ride to the top of Gubalowka Mountain for a great view of the Tatra Mountains. After descending from Gubalowka you have free time to shop the colorful open market place where you will find leather goods, sheepskin items, local cheese, and all kinds of wonderful gifts and souvenirs for yourself and for friends at home. In the early evening we will take a short drive to the village of Chocholow famous for its unique log-houses. We will stop to visit a local wood-carver and afterwards we enjoy dinner at a nearby highlander inn with lively music and folklore.

## **MAY 14 - THU ZAKOPANE - DUNAJEC RIVER RAFTING - KRAKOW ( B, L )**

In the morning we leave Zakopane and take a short drive to enjoy a relaxing and picturesque river rafting experience on the Dunajec River (weather permitting). Winding through the spectacular scenery of the Pieniny National Park we will be zig-zagging back and forth across the Polish and Slovak border. Lunch at a local inn and then we continue our drive to Krakow.

The rest of the evening is at your leisure.

## **MAY 15 - FRI KRAKOW ( B, L )**

We will start our tour this morning by bus to visit the former Jewish district of Kazimierz, which has recently become a very trendy area filled with many charming cafes and restaurants. We then continue to Wawel Hill with the gothic Cathedral where many kings of Poland were buried. We continue by foot to Europe's largest Market Square, with the Cloth Hall as its centerpiece as well as St. Mary's Church. Our tour will end with lunch near the Market Square and then the rest of the day is yours to explore on your own.

## **MAY 16 - SAT KRAKOW - WIELICZKA - KRAKOW ( B, FAREWELL DINNER)**

Morning excursion to the outskirts of Krakow to visit the Wieliczka Salt Mine. The mine is Poland's top attraction, with underground chambers, grottoes, and chapels all carved from salt. After our visit at Wieliczka we return to Krakow and the afternoon is at your leisure to explore at your own pace or to do some last minute shopping.
